

Today is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord! This is like another Epiphany, only its 33 years after His Birth! In the Jordan River, the Lord is now shown, revealed, manifested, to the world to be the *Son of God*. REFUGEE UPDATE

We are still awaiting the arrival of our first refugee family. We received a note two weeks ago from Immigration and the Visa Office in Beirut, "I am glad to inform you that Immigration has confirmed the approval of your application to sponsor Ayman Krait, Principal Applicant, with a family size of 3. (Ayman, Suzyi and Stephanie.) With a few more odds and ends, the house will be ready for this family. Hopefully they will arrive soon, and begin their transition to a new land. It has been highly recommended by our Diocese and by some Refugee experts, that we house the two families together for a period until they are more settled. We can only imagine how traumatized they must be, having been driven from their homeland, having witnessed some horrible things, and then having been in a Refugee Camp in Lebanon for some 18 months. We have a fourbedroom house on Maple Street which can certainly accommodate both families for a period. We still have some furniture to pick up from parishioners. We have also received a lot of clothing donations from our parishioners. Many thanks. Once we know the exact sizes of the 4 adults and 3 children we will publish it in the bulletin.

We will have a former refugee here to address our group, and to give us some insights into what to expect, and how to make the transition easier for the families.
