The Pastor's Pen

Dear Friends:

We are back in Ordinary Time. Christmas officially ended this past Monday with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Today is the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time! There is nothing 'ordinary' if we keep the message and spirit of Christmas alive all year!

The readings for this Sunday have to do with God's calling! God calls Samuel in the First Reading, and we get Samuel's response, "Speak Lord for your servant is listening." Our Psalm proclaims, "Here I am Lord; I come to do your will!" The Gospel is a beautiful scene where two men ask Jesus "where are you staying?" And Jesus answers, "Come and see!" Simon and Andrew follow Jesus, and their lives are changed forever!

Two thousand years later Jesus calls each of us. What is your calling? What is my calling? The answer is simple: we are called to serve God. The answer is a mystery, the mystery of our lives. We pray for the grace and courage to be attentive to God's call. We pray for the courage to follow Him, so that when He calls we will freely respond, "Speak Lord, your servant is listening."

John Cardinal Newman once wrote, "God has created me for some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have a mission. I have a part in a great work. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for nothing. I shall do good. I shall do His work. I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, even if I do not realize what I am doing. But, if I keep His commandments, I will serve Him in my calling."

What is one thing God is calling me to do? What can I do to keep his mission and ministry alive... today, tomorrow... this week... next week? Have a blessed week of following, and keeping the spirit of Christmas alive!
