Dear Friends.

The Christmas Season may be over, but there's no reason we can't keep the spirit of Christmas alive all year! Together we can spread his light and love wherever we go this year!

Our Gospel today jumps ahead some 30 years from last Sunday. It takes us to the very beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Jesus had been baptized, and now John the Baptist sees Jesus coming toward him and he declares, "Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" John had seen the Spirit descend "like a dove" and remain on Jesus at his Baptism. When that happened, John finally knew the one he had been expecting and preparing the people to receive. This is the one who would baptize with the Holy Spirit.

Next Sunday we will see the call of the first disciples. Our ministry... our vocation, is to point out the *Lamb of God* to the world. That is, **point** Christ out to others! Be Christ for others. See the Christ in others. We may be back in Ordinary Time... but this is an extraordinary call... a sacred vocation for all of us.

As a beautiful poem by Howard Thurman says:

When the song of the angels is silent When the star in the sky is gone When the wise men are back in their homeland When the shepherds are again tending their sheep When the manger is darkened and still The work of Christmas begins. . .

To find the lost, To heal the broken, To feed the hungry, To shelter the homeless, To rebuild the nations, To teach God's Children, To bring peace among people, To befriend the lonely, To release the prisoner, To make music in the heart.

Church Roof Update

We received the inspection report of our church roof. The wooden deck is in good shape. The slate is in good condition. The main problem? The slates were installed with 'clips' only. No nails. And the clips are too short for the thickness of the slate. For this climate, they should have been installed with copper nails. The section where we are having the most problems, [behind the church tower], will need to be replaced. This is a section where snow and ice builds up, causing the clips to pop or straighten out. This would be an immediate solution (approx. \$35-\$40,000.00). Long term solution? The roof will need to be replaced. It is cheaper to install new slates, than it is to remove and re-install the old slates. The old slates can be sold. It would be more expensive to put on a commercial metal roof. A representative from the company, Semper Gooder, will be here in the next 2 weeks to get some extensive drone footage, and provide us with the best options. Samples of the wood deck, nails and clips are available in the parish office! We'll keep you posted.
