

Today's bulletin is for January 20th and January 27th!

Sunday, January 20, 2019

Last Sunday was Jesus' baptism at the age of 30, and of course, only after his baptism, did he begin to BE the Messiah in very public ways! Today we have *The Wedding Feast at Cana*, Jesus' first miracle in John's Gospel. As the wedding went on, the wine ran out. So Mary brought it to Jesus' attention, and Jesus (after being somewhat guick with his mother) performed the miracle of turning water into wine. He did not let the folks down, he rescued them in their difficulty. This revealed his glory and led the disciples to believe in him. All in God's time! Jesus does not let any of us down.

St. Paul reminds us that God's gifts to us are not meant primarily for personal use, but for the service of others. He tells of the many gifts of the Holy Spirit to each person, to each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good, not for personal profit. The Spirit is manifested in you and me! Wow! Do we act that way? Do others see that? Do my neighbors know that? What gifts do I have? What has God bestowed me with? Or we use the proverbial, what am I good at? Am I using my gifts for my own personal profit or do I use them for the service of others? ... my time, talent and treasure? Imagine if we used our gifts for the common good, even the gifts of praying, singing, teaching, caring, sharing, encouraging, supporting, motivating! Then these gifts will grow and soon we'll see more miracles. Service to others and concern for others is the beginning of all miracles. Now, go and share that Good News! Be good wine, deep love, deep concern for others! Be miracle workers! May we allow God to turn all our selfishness into service! And hopefully, our winter into spring!

Sunday, January 27, 2019

This Sunday we have two public readings from the Law and the Prophets, by Ezra and Jesus! Very dramatic scenes! In the book of Nehemiah, Ezra read from the Mosaic Law to the returned exiles at the *Water Gate* in Jerusalem. They listened with understanding, and the readings were interpreted for them. They were so deeply moved that they fell on their faces to worship the Lord and they wept. Nehemiah told them that this is a holy day and a cause for joy and celebration! He encouraged them to share with those who have nothing.

Several centuries later, the people go to the synagogue in Nazareth, to hear the *Law and the Prophets!* Jesus had returned home to Nazareth, knowing who he is and what his mission from God is. With the assurance of a prophet, he read from Isaiah, those powerful, passages of the Servant Song. He proclaimed his mission, here in the town where he grew up: he has come for the poor, the captives, the blind, the oppressed. It is an electrifying moment when he says, "Today, this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

Twenty centuries later, these words place the same demands on us. The passage from Isaiah that Jesus makes his own, is not only the ministry of Jesus, but it is also the mission for all of us, the Church. We have a powerful mission to liberate the poor, the captives, the blind, the oppressed. We, as baptized Christians, have the power to fulfill this scripture passage in our hearing also! Maybe this week we can each do one thing for one person... to put flesh on these readings.
