FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends.

As I write this Bulletin letter (Wednesday Night), we anxiously await word from our Diocese about the opening of our churches. On Thursday, June 11, we will be having a Council of Priests Meeting; and then a Virtual Zoom Meeting for all priests in the diocese on Friday. From these sessions, we will be given instructions and safety practices to be put into place, before we can open our churches to the faithful. Please keep an eye out on our Parish Website! If all goes well, we may be able to have Mass this weekend, with measures in place! Stay tuned.

This Sunday we celebrate *The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ!* Our first reading from Deuteronomy has Moses speaking to the Israelites after their 40 year journey in the wilderness. They are about to enter the Promised Land. Moses wants them to always remember what God has done for them! As they faced constant hardships, God fed them daily with manna, made water flow for them, protected them from snakes and scorpions, and led them through "the great and terrible wilderness!" God never left his people alone or abandoned! That's honestly how I feel during this Pandemic. No matter how bleak things were, I never felt alone or abandoned. That carries us through rough times, especially through a Pandemic Wilderness with so many unknowns.



In John's Gospel, Jesus refers to himself as "the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever!" And this is what Jesus gave to us on the night before he died, his very self in his **Body and Blood**.... so that we are never left on our own, so that we will never hunger. We remember the Last Supper and Jesus' New Covenant every

time we gather at the Altar: *This is my Body given for you... this is my blood poured out for you!* At the Altar, we celebrate all God has done for us in and through his Son! I can't wait to be back at the Altar of St. Pat's with you. It will be a real joy to worship together again.

This is a great feast to be reminded of how far God was willing to go to show that he never gives up on us; that he loves us. How generous! The Eucharist is the source and the summit from which the whole life and power of the Church flows. It's the source of our drive, our energy. And this for us is the sacrament of ongoing conversion. Being fed and nourished with the Body and Blood of Christ, we should be constantly changing... and certainly, willing to try harder to be more like Christ! We need to keep coming back to the Table, to be fed, nourished and strengthened for the journey! And like the Israelites, we need to be constantly reminded of the depth of God's love! See you at the Altar! Sooner rather than later!!! God bless!
