

On behalf of the parish I extend a *Happy Father's Day* to all the fathers in our parish... and to all who must assume a fatherly role in the lives of our children. We also remember in a sacred way, our fathers who have died. May they rest in peace with our Heavenly Father.

Summer is officially here on Tuesday, with the Summer Solstice! As school draws to a close, we wish our students, teachers, principals and school staff a very safe, happy and healthy summer.

We continue our prayers for the victims and families of the mass shooting in Orlando this past week. It's heart-breaking, and frightening. When will this madness end? All the more reason to keep up our prayers for world peace, and for a greater respect between people of all cultures and creeds.



In today's Gospel, Jesus asks a question to his disciples, Who do you say that I am? Peter's answer pleased Jesus, You are the Christ of God. Then Jesus tells them about what will happen to him, suffering, death and resurrection. And then he called them to deny themselves, take up their

cross and follow him, and lose their lives for His sake.

Someone wrote: It's clear from what Jesus says, that being his disciple is not a part-time job; something we do on Sunday at church and occasionally doing a few good deeds during the week. Taking up the cross isn't a part-time practice we do on Good Friday, or when we are feeling strong and resilient. Nor is sacrifice in Jesus' name something reserved for some specially selected martyrs whose names are inscribed on monuments. Instead, Jesus says losing our lives for his sake must be daily. It's not a part-time religion; it's a full-time following! Nor is taking up his cross for a select few disciples, but for all who follow him.

Who is Jesus for me? Is he there only when I'm desperate and need his help? Is he someone to whom I **truly** turn my life and my will over every day? Is he someone to whom I trust with my life? Only you and I can answer that for ourselves! Who do you say that I am? If he is the *Christ of God*, and our Savior, then let's do what he asks, take up his cross daily and follow him! And only God knows where that will take us! We need only be open to his calling! Have a Christo-centric week!
