#### Dear Friends.

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, commonly known as Trinity Sunday. Belief in the Trinity is at the very centre of our lives as Christians, Three Persons in One God.

As Catholic-Christians we have many rituals, one being the way we begin and end all prayers: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit! It's one of the first things we teach our little

children, how to bless themselves by making the Sign of the Cross... the sign of God's eternal love for us, the sign of the Trinity. The Sign of the Cross is a strong affirmation of our faith.
