

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends:



HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY!!!! May you live as long as you want, and never want as long as you live! HAPPY ST. JOSEPH'S DAY!!!! St. Joseph is the Patron of the Universal Church! His feast is celebrated this year on Monday, March 20!

Good News: The <u>spring equinox</u> arrives in Niagara at 12:57 p.m. on Monday, March 20, marking an official end to winter in the Northern Hemisphere! Mother Nature decided to give us a good blast of winter this past week! It was actually *Sheilagh's Brush*!!! (In weather legend, NL recognizes a winter storm that falls near St. Patrick's Day as Sheilagh's Brush!) We handled it though! Before we know it, plants will be in full bloom and the trees will be waving their new leaves in the air!!!



This is the 3rd Sunday in Lent! Today's Gospel scene is powerful, yet shocking for its day! Jesus is nearing Sychar, a Samaritan City. He stops to rest at Jacob's Well. And a **Samaritan Woman** comes to draw water at noon! Well, this says much! Women drew water in the morning. She was avoiding others! After all, she has been

through five husbands and the one she was living with now, was not her husband. Most likely, she was the topic for gossip at the Tim Horton's in Sychar! She avoids being seen! When she reaches the Well, there's a man there. Not just a man, it was a Jewish man! Men and women were not seen in public together. Samaritans and Jews were known enemies! The woman is not only startled to see him, but more startled that he spoke to her! Ah, but it's Jesus! Everyone matters to God!

The woman's life was out of kilter. Unhappy. Jesus knew every detail about her! Wow! Then he used the symbol of *water* to explain the spiritual refreshment that he is bringing to the world. He said, *The water that I will give will become... a spring of water gushing up to eternal life.* She knew she was sinful, and that her problems were her own fault. She felt guilt and shame. She knew she needed a Saviour. She longed to be close to God. Jesus offered her **a new lease on life...fresh living water!** Something new, something real, welled up inside of her. A new spirit! She left her jar behind... representing her sinful past! And she spread the good news about Jesus to her town! If you get a chance this week, read John 4: 5-42.

Our challenge is to recapture the Samaritan Woman's sense of awe and wonder. We need to remember that God is still present, *here and now*. Waiting to respond. Offering us a wellspring of **living water** which leads to eternal life. If we feel we have dried up, *then come deeper into the well of faith!* Maybe we are thirsting for **forgiveness** in the parched land of our sins, or thirsting for **hope** in the dry despair of our frustrations. May we allow Christ to **pour life-giving water** into the drought of our lives. Allow him to pour his love and grace into every crevice of our dried and broken spirits. He can do marvelous things if we only **come to the well** with him! May this be a rejuvenating week for all of us.
