Spring officially springs this Sunday! Praise God! Spring equinox happens on Sunday, March 20, at 11:33 A.M. EDT. Before we know it, everything will be in full bloom again!



We are entering the 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of Lent! If we ever wonder what God is like, our readings this Sunday tell us so much! We have a God of **second chances**. In Exodus, the Israelites wandered far from home... to Egypt. They strayed from God, evil

befell them, but did God abandon them? Absolutely not. God's nurturing hands were held out to them. From the burning bush, Moses was called to lead his people from slavery to freedom!
