

Spiritual Communion

For those times you cannot attend Mass, such as during this coronavirus pandemic, you can still reach out to Christ by making a Spiritual Communion in prayer! This is strongly encouraged. If we watch Mass on TV during this crisis, make a Spiritual Communion! It's a powerful act of devotion!

St. Thomas Aquinas defined a Spiritual Communion as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament [in Communion at Mass] and in lovingly embracing Him as if we had actually received Him." You can make a Spiritual Communion anywhere the Spirit moves you.

Prayer for Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

Or

Oh Jesus, I turn toward the Holy Tabernacle where You live hidden for love of me. I love you, O my God. I cannot receive you in Holy Communion. Come, nevertheless, and visit me with Your grace. Come spiritually into my heart. Purify it. Sanctify it. Render it like unto Your own. Amen.

Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends!

It's Wednesday night, March 18th! It's the day after St. Patrick's Day and the day before St. Joseph's Day! May all the Saints of God intercede for us. It's hard to feel calm and peace when we are caught up in a worldwide storm of health crisis. There are so many unknowns with this corona virus (Covid-19). It will do us good to pause and reflect on what the Angel said to Mary, "Do not be afraid". How often God spoke to others through an Angel, with the same words. Of course we feel afraid. That's normal and natural. But we can't let it paralyze us or overwhelm us. So many changes, restrictions and precautions have had to be made in the past week or so, in how we live our daily lives. The best thing we can do is to refrain from panicking, use our common sense, and plug into our faith. Prayer is a powerful weapon. Now we really have to use it. Pray that this will end. Pray for all the victims and families, and for all who are working on the front lines, doctors, nurses, scientists.

As you are aware by now, all public Masses and liturgies have been cancelled until at least April 18th. This is unprecedented in our time. There will be no Holy Week Liturgies or Easter Sunday Masses. But it's something that has to be done for the safety of God's people. During this time we know that you have requested that Masses be celebrated each day for your loved ones intentions. This will not change. Myself and Fr. Marc will still be celebrating a private Daily Mass to fulfill your requests and intentions. Be assured of that. In this special bulletin we have included the Daily Mass Intentions for the next three weeks. I just came in from the church (9:00 PM), having celebrated a private Mass for Ana Skrbinsek and Sergio Simonetti. And this will be done every day until this crisis is over. We promise you that.

So now we have an entire month or perhaps more without public Mass. But we don't have an entire month without prayer. Your family is the Church, don't forget. The Church is the *People of God*. And that is me and you! Watch Mass on TV. Make a Spiritual Communion (prayer included in this bulletin)! Take out your Bibles, pray a Psalm. Read a passage, and then reflect on the images in that passage. Pray a Rosary with your family. Pray the Stations of the Cross with your children. Close your eyes, and picture Jesus and those he encounters on each step of that journey. See ourselves in there. Bring the shape and colours of the Stations of the Cross from our church into your mind. Maybe put a little white cloth on the end of your dining room table, light a candle and place a crucifix on it. Pray we must.



Please reach out to your family or other parishioners who are not online and share the updates. Our parish office will remain open for telephone business only. We ask that you not come to the office. Call ahead and we will gladly place things in the mailbox for you, or you can call ahead and then drop things off in the mailbox for us. If we cut back on office hours, we will not cut back on our staff pay. I promised them that. We all have to do our part to ease the burden on everyone. If you know of anyone who needs anything, let me know, and trust me, I'll get the help for them. The church will be open on Sunday mornings from 10 AM until 12 Noon for private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, and also Monday to Friday from 12 Noon to 1PM. Please use Main front door only. Wheelchair access will be available as needed. Remember, you must sit at least 3 feet from another person. Instructions will be on all doors.

May God bless and protect all of us during this time of crisis. Fr. Gerard



This is Laetare Sunday?

Although we cannot gather for Mass, *Laetare Sunday* is the popular name for the Fourth Sunday in Lent. The name comes from the first word of the entrance antiphon of today's Mass: In Latin, (Isaiah 66:10-11) begins "*Laetare, Jerusalem*" ("Rejoice, Jerusalem"). Since there are six Sundays in <u>Lent</u>, Laetare Sunday falls just past the midpoint of <u>Lent</u>. For that reason, Laetare Sunday has traditionally been viewed as a day of celebration, on which the austerity of Lent is briefly lessened; the organ is played, flowers are allowed on the altar, and the purple vestments of Lent, signifying penance, are set aside and, as on <u>Gaudete Sunday</u> in <u>Advent</u>, rose ones are used instead.
