Dear Friends in Christ:

This past Sunday night I was in a video conference with the Carmelite Provincial in Chicago and the Philippines, and with Fr. Joi. Things are finally moving along. We should be expecting Fr. Joi shortly after Easter. He will be our new Associate Pastor. We will update you when we have a final date. We will welcome Fr. Joi with great joy! His official name is Fr. Joiezl Fern S. Piñon, O.Carm. He has been ordained for three years, and is quite excited about coming to minister in Canada.

The Giving Bowl "A Lenten Sacrifice" for St. Pat's!

We have special boxes at the front and back of the church. All donations will assist *The Giving Bowl*, which feeds up to 1100 children at local Catholic Schools in Eastern Uganda. This is the only hot meal these children get each day. They also assist with medical issues, uniforms and tuition. Please place your donations into these containers during Lent! This is a Registered Charity under the CRA, and they issue their own receipts for Income Tax Purposes. Approximately 80% of their funds go directly to the Food Program. The other 20% is used for school fees for the most desperate, a school uniform to replace the most tattered, also notebooks and pencils, medical supplies, and in dire cases, to purchase a goat for very needy families. If you use the parish offertory envelopes, you must make the cheque payable to *St. Patrick Parish*. We issue a cheque to *The Giving Bowl* at the end of each month.

Damage to Property

During the past few months we have had some damage done to our church property. We've had parts of our sprinkler system torn from the ground, signs stolen and destroyed, electrical boxes and wires torn off the lamp posts and wall in front of the church. Thankfully, our video cameras captured the incidents. Last week an arrest was made. The perpetrator is not permitted to enter our property again. If you're driving by the church at night or during the day and see anything unusual, please do not hesitate to call us or call the police. Extra lighting has been installed around the church, so hopefully this will be a further deterrent.
