

We continue to keep the people of Ukraine in prayer. The images and stories continue to be very painful and disturbing. We pray for this war to end, and that peace will prevail. Please see the requests for help in this bulletin.

Today is the 4th Sunday of Lent, *Laetare* Sunday. This is a Sunday of joy. We are halfway through Lent, and the mood is one of hope and rejoicing because Easter is coming near. The reading from Joshua recounts the celebration of the Passover in the Promised Land by Joshua and those who had been in the desert for 40 years. 
