

!!!!! Church Roof- Sub-Committee !!!!!

Once again, we are having a problem with slates coming off the church roof during wind storms. It is in the same section as before (school side). We had 12 slates replaced in 2020, and we also had the roof inspected. Provincial Roofing, at the request of our insurance company, was here before Holy Week and replaced 13 more slates. This 1895 roof was replaced in 1989, using clips. This apparently is at the source of the problem. All the slates had pre-drilled holes, but it appears that the only slates that are nailed are at the bottom sections. These clips are snapping and coming up with the pressure of the wind, and also with ice. Would you like to volunteer to be on a sub-committee so we can look at all options for our roof? There are some indications of water damage on the church ceiling and above the altar. This needs to be addressed immediately. Please call the parish office if you would like to volunteer to be on this committee. We have two people, [one man and one woman], who have called to volunteer. A few more would be great. We will be having a Parish Council Meeting shortly to determine the best approach.

Today's Gospel is Jesus' third appearance since his Resurrection. Peter and his companions have returned to their old jobs, fishing. Had they lost hope? This is the same place from where Jesus called them three years earlier. After fishing all night they caught nothing. Then in the

morning, Jesus appeared and told them to cast their nets to the other side of the boat. And they had a great haul of fish!!! 153 in total! It pays to listen to the Master! And then Jesus prepares a meal of bread and fish over a charcoal fire!

Then we have a powerful dialogue between Jesus and Peter. Remember, Peter had denied Jesus three times. Now Jesus demands a triple affirmation from Peter as a negation of his triple denial on Good Friday. He asks him, "Do you love me?", three times! Peter is now being called to show that he really loves Jesus. How? Care for my people, feed my lambs, tend my sheep! Simply put, so must we. Jesus was raised from the dead so we can share in His life, and bring this life to others.

Jesus calls out to us, "Do you love me?" How do we answer? Surely, not by words alone, but by how we live our Christian lives, how we spread the Good News, how we reach out and feed his people! So many people depend on us, every day. People in our town of Niagara, and from many corners of the world are looking to us. From Niagara Falls to Eastern Uganda! We have a mission to complete as members of the Body of Christ. We need to fulfill our function within the Body for the good of the world by proclaiming Jesus Christ with our lives. A New Carmelite Saint

Blessed Titus Brandsma, O. Carm., will be canonized on Sunday, May 15, 2022 in St Peter's Square. Finally, 80 years after his death and 37 years after his beatification, Fr. Titus can be venerated as a saint by the entire



Catholic Church. The Carmelite Order, the Church in The Netherlands, as well as the entire Carmelite Family joyfully welcome this much awaited news. Brandsma, the 'dangerous little friar', ran foul of the Nazi authorities in Holland during World War II for his stance against Nazi ideology and anti-Semitism. He fought to keep Nazi propaganda out of the Catholic and secular press and to

keep Jewish children in Catholic schools. He was arrested, imprisoned and finally sent to Dachau Concentration Camp where he was killed by lethal injection on 26 July 1942. (Fr. Titus visited Mount Carmel in Niagara Falls in the 1930's and gave a lecture. While there he wrote some magnificent things about the thunderous Falls!)
