# PASTOR

It's hard to believe that the Easter Season has come to an end! And we are finally getting some nice weather. But may we never forget that every Sunday is a 'Little Easter'! Today is the Solemnity of Pentecost! The Birthday of the Church. The church is dressed in RED, depicting the *tongues of fire* that came upon the disciples. Acts of the Apostles gives a vivid account of the day of Pentecost - tongues of fire, sounds of a violent wind, many languages, crowds galore!



John's Gospel tells us of the Risen Christ appearing through locked doors in the Upper Room on Easter evening. He breathed on the Apostles and gave them life in the same way his Father had breathed on Adam and gave him life. "As the Father has sent me, so I send you," Jesus said. And in those words from Christ, they were called out of comfort, out of safety... out of the *Upper Room* into the challenging

life of proclaiming the Gospel. St. Paul talks about a variety of gifts, services, activities and how the same Spirit activates all of them. All of us together are formed by the Holy Spirit into one Body of Christ. All sent out to proclaim the Good News!

Christ calls us out of the Upper Rooms of our lives also, out of our comfort zones... to embrace the challenges of the Gospel.
