

PASTOR

Dear Friends:

This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. As the old hymn sings: Alleluia! Not as orphans, are we left in sorrow now; Alleluia! He is near us, faith believes, nor questions how. Though the cloud from sight received him, when the forty days were o'er, shall our hearts forget his promise, "I am with you ever more." We are told in Luke's Gospel that Jesus lifted up his hands, and he blessed them. While

he was blessing them he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. In Acts, Jesus told the Apostles that they will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth! Then he was lifted up and a cloud took him out of their sight.

The mission of the Apostles and our mission and ministry is the same: Be my witnesses to the ends of the earth! We are also commissioned to go out and tell the world about Jesus, and preach through our lives, all the while, storing up treasures in heaven! St. Augustine said, "Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven; let our hearts ascend with him. Listen to the words of the Apostle: If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth. For just as he remained with us even after his ascension, so we too are already in heaven with him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies." Ascension also gives us insight into the deeper reality of Pentecost which we will celebrate next Sunday. The breath of God, His Spirit, has been breathed into each of us, to enable us to live differently... beginning right now. We are to participate in the ongoing redemptive mission of Jesus Christ, with our hearts and minds fixed firmly on our heavenly goal.

We can be so busy doing things, accumulating, achieving, that we easily forget what life is all about, preparing to meet God in heaven. This feast reminds us that we are only passing through this earth! We are pilgrims on a journey. Just as Jesus' earthly life was temporary, our lives are also temporary. It will come to an end, and our hope is that we will meet God face to face in the next life. And our mission is the same as the Apostles, Be my witnesses to the ends of the earth! Maybe this week, we can give witness to God, by doing one concrete act of charity, as our way of preaching the Good News! If we each do 'one' thing, we can certainly transform our families and towns, and before long, our world! Happy Ascension... and never forget, "what goes up, must come down!" Stay tuned.

Back in the day, a man would adorn his beloved's doors with flowers on this Feast, and give her a cricket cage, too. This Feast is also known in parts of Italy as "La Festa del Grillo" (the Feast of the Cricket). And we thought we knew it all!
