

HOSPITALITY ASKED FROM ST. PATRICK CHURCH

In August 2015, Pope Francis erected an Apostolic Exarchate for the Syro-Malabar Catholic faithful in Canada with its See in Mississauga.



Fr. Jose Kalluvelil was appointed its first Bishop Exarch. He was assigned the titular see of "Tabalta", with the Inauguration of the new Exarchy, and his Episcopal ordination. There are currently about 200 members of the Syro-Malabar faith in the Greater Niagara area, including 50 children. Some have been attending our Roman churches here in Niagara for

years. They have no church building in this area. **Bishop Bergie** phoned me this week, and asked if our parish would consider hosting their congregation for their Sunday Mass and catechesis. I spoke with the new Syro-Malabar Bishop Jose, and he sent **Rev. Fr. John Mylamvelil** and some members to meet with me on Wednesday. The congregation would have catechesis for the children at 3:00 PM in the Hall or Gym or classroom, followed by Mass at 4:30 PM in the Church. They would be finished by 6:00 PM, so that we can set up for our own 7:00 PM Sunday Night Mass. I think this is a wonderful opportunity for St. Pat's to offer a worship space and hospitality for the new congregation of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church. Their first Mass (without catechesis) will be this Sunday at 4:00 PM.

Each year the Serra Club of St. Catharines asks us to submit the names of two *Altar Servers* to receive an award of recognition for their service to the Church. On Tuesday evening at a special Mass in St. Alfred's Church, Bishop Bergie presented an award to *Patrick Abbott, Brandon Molina and Billy Kimonos*. It would be great if we could submit the names of all our faithful and dedicated altar servers, but your turn will come next year! Many thanks to all our servers for their awesome commitment. We still require more servers for Saturday 5:00 PM Mass, and Sunday 11:30 AM Mass.

Parish Assessment and Discernment

This Sunday at all Masses, our parishioners will be asked to complete a survey as part of the Diocesan Parish Discernment. This is **mandated** by Bishop Bergie. The survey will be simple to complete, by using an "X". There will be two questions that we will have to give a very brief answer:

1) What is one thing you like best about the parish? and 2) What is the one greatest challenge or need facing the parish? This survey is done anonymously, and will be processed by a company outside the Diocese. This survey will be done in lieu of a homily. Thanks for your understanding and cooperation, in helping our Diocese assess its parishes. Fear not, St. Pat's is in no danger of closing, but this process needs to be done by all parishes!!!
