

#### From Bishop Bergie on CHRISTMAS MASSES

The celebration of Christmas is a little over a month away. I am sure that many of you have begun thinking about how you will celebrate this feast in the midst of a pandemic. One of the more significant issues that we will have to face is the unknown. How many people will be coming to our Christmas Masses? Will there be large or small crowds? Each parish may experience things a little differently depending on location and demographics. I would like to offer you the following considerations as you make your preparations in churches that are only at 30 percent capacity with physical distancing.

- 1. For this year only, Christmas Vigil Masses can begin at 3 pm. This will allow for an additional Mass if needed.
- 2. As pastoral need necessitates, priests have permission to say up to three Masses per day.
- 3. For parishes anticipating large crowds, it is recommended that you preregister people. You can decide the best way to do this depending on your circumstances. There is a free computer program; however, if this process is done by phoning the parish office, it will allow those without a computer to participate.
- 4. If people are unable to attend Mass on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day due to lack of space or concern regarding crowds, they should be reminded that the Church in her wisdom has established the Octave of Christmas. Individuals can celebrate Christmas and attend Mass on any of the eight days.
- 5. Concerns about crowds may also provide an opportunity to promote early morning Christmas Masses where, in recent times, the numbers have not been large.
- 6. It is important to note that the general dispensation for Sunday Masses also applies to Holy Days of Obligation (Christmas and Mary Mother of God).

#### Christmas Gift Campaign

We have started our Annual Christmas Gift Campaign. We still have gift tags available for children of different ages in our two schools, but given the protocols, we can only use Gift Cards this year. Parents will shop for their own children. Grocery cards for families will also be included with the gifts this year. Many thanks for your help. The deadline for returning gifts is December 6th.

#### **Advent Reconciliation**

There will be no Communal Reconciliation Service. In its place, on Saturday, December 12th and December 19th, priests will be available in the Sacristy and in the Ushers Room between 11:00 AM and 12:30 PM. Entry through Main Doors of Church. Masks must be worn except for medical reasons, and 6-foot distance must be maintained. Reconciliation is available any time by appointment.
