The month of November is here and so is the chill of Fall upon us. November is designated as a special month to pray for our beloved



dead. Thursday was **All Soul's Day!** A special Memorial Mass was celebrated on Friday night where we remembered all those who have died in our parish since last November. It was a very moving liturgy. A


candle was lit and bells were chimed, as the names of some 70 faithful departed were proclaimed from the Altar of God.

On Thursday we began a **Nine-Day Novena of Masses** for All Souls. The names of our loved ones enrolled in this Novena, are placed on the altar and remembered during these Nine Holy Masses. A **Book of Life** is also placed in front of the Altar, and we ask you to write the names of your loved ones in this book. They will be remembered at all Masses, prayers and Rosaries during the entire month. May the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace!

Every evening when we prayed the Family Rosary during my childhood, my father would always remember the dead, especially *those who have no one left to pray for them*! And he would always pray for the Souls in Purgatory. I've never forgot that intention. Praying for our faithful departed is such an essential and important part of our faith. Every time I pass a cemetery I pray the "Eternal Rest" prayer.

And while we are praying for all who have died.... we also need to remember those who are grieving, all those whose grief is still so fresh. We have experienced many deaths in our parish this past year. We entrust all our grieving families to God's tender care and love, and to Mary's gentle embrace. May they find the strength to face each day without the physical presence of their loved ones. Have a blessed week, and a prayerful month.

#### So Why Do We Pray For the Dead?

Our Church has taught for centuries that our prayers assist those who have died. We commend their souls to God's mercy and we pray for them. Masses, prayers for the dead, Rosaries, Stations of the Cross, and other devotions, are for the most part, petitions to God. They ask that the departed believer may be united in an eternal embrace with the Triune God , *Father, Son, and Holy Spirit* in heaven. For that goal was each of us created, for that purpose did Christ die and rise again, and for that end do we pray when we commend the souls of "the faithful departed" to God.

All our beloved dead **still need** our prayers. I am sure that very few, if any, human beings go directly into heaven at the time of death. There still has to be a purging **(purification-Purgatory)** before we will experience the beatific vision of God, meeting God face to face! That's why our Church teaches in her Catechism, ""All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." And so we pray:

Into your hands, O Lord, we humbly entrust our brothers and sisters.

In this life you embraced them with your tender love; deliver them now from every evil and bid them enter eternal rest.

The old order has passed away;
welcome them into Paradise,
where there will be no sorrow, no weeping nor pain,
but fullness of peace and joy
with your Son and the Holy Spirit forever and ever. Amen.
