The Pastot's Pen

Dear Friends:

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable to some political and religious leaders of his day. It's about two sons. The father asks both to go and work in the vineyard. The first says **NO**, but changes his mind and goes. The second says **YES**, but does not go! Both changed their minds! The **first son** represents the tax collectors, prostitutes, and other sinners. The **second son** represents the Jewish authorities. The first son was blatantly rude: "I will not go," but he had a change of heart. He came out



all right. The second son knew what to say to his father. "I will certainly go, sir," but he blew it in the end. Jesus was poking fun at the scribes and Pharisees for their pride in having all the externals perfectly in order, while being blind to God's call in their lives. They did not heed John the Baptist! They

had a chance to hear what John had to say about justice and righteousness, but they chose to remain fixated on external laws. Jesus clearly divides people into those who act and those who don't.

Having knowledge of Jesus' words and sayings, or knowing the Bible inside out, is one thing, but we have to build our lives on 'actions' and on 'love-put-into-practice'. Good intentions do not suffice. Promises are useless if they're not kept. Jesus uses the faith of the tax collectors and prostitutes who heard John's message and then changed their ways, as a model for his followers. Where am I in all this? Am I part of the YES crowd or the NO crowd? Do my actions match my words? Do I walk the Christian talk? That's the challenge for us, to have our deeds match our words. Being Christian needs to be evident in the way we live. There must be no chasm between our words, actions, and faith. I know we can all try harder. If we do mess up, or stray off the path, our God of second chances invites us back, loves us and forgives us. Have a faith-into-action week!

Weekday Rosary

October, Month of the Holy Rosary



The month of October is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. The liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7th. It was instituted to honour the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she

gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful. The feast was introduced by Pope St. Pius V (1504-1572) in the year 1571 to commemorate the miraculous victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The pope attributed more to the "arms" of the Rosary than the power of cannons and the valor of the soldiers who fought there. Legend tells us that the Rosary as a form of prayer, was given to St. Dominic (1170- 1221) by Mary, the Mother of Our Lord, who entrusted it to him as an aid in the conflicts with the Albigensians (.13th Cent. heretics). The Dominican pope, St. Pius V, did much to further the spread of the Rosary and it thereafter became one of the most popular devotions in the Church.

Feast of St. Therese, The Little Flower

October 1st is the Feast of our great Carmelite Saint, St. Therese of



Lisieux, Patroness of the Missions! She lived a short 24 years from 1873-1897, in Alencon and Lisieux, France. She has become the most popular saint of all times. Her autobiography, *The Story of a Soul*, has been translated into over 50 languages! St. Therese taught us the "Little

Way!" And that is, finding God in the ordinary everyday activities of life! When Pope John Paul II declared her Doctor of the Church in 1997, he called her "a young Carmelite who was filled with the love of God, who offered herself completely to his love, and who knew how to practice love of neighbour in the ordinary things of daily life." That is certainly a call to all of us! Therese wrote, "Miss no single opportunity of making some small sacrifice, here by a smiling look, there by a kindly word; always doing the smallest right and doing it all for love!" She also said, "You know well enough that Our Lord does not look so much at the greatness of our actions, nor even at their difficulty, but at the love at which we do them." Unfortunately this feast falls on Sunday this year, so we cannot celebrate a votive Mass.
