

OCTOBER 25, & NOVEMBER 1 2020

Parish bulletins are being printed every two weeks. Today's bulletin is for October 25th and November 1st (All Saint's Day). They will be passed to you at the church exits. The bulletin is also published on our Parish Website.

30th Sunday October 25, 2020

In today's Gospel, the Pharisees are putting Jesus to the test again. They ask, "Teacher, which commandment in the Law is the greatest?" Jesus responds, You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. He says this is the greatest and first commandment! Then he adds, You shall love your neighbour as yourself. We can't just love God on a part time basis! We must love God with everything we are, and with everything we have, with our very being, heart, soul and mind. And also, we can't just love our neighbour sometimes, we must love our neighbour at all times. If we love God deeply, then it comes natural to bring God's love to those around us. It is simply not possible to love God and not love our neighbour! To love God is to recognize his image in every person. Every person bears the likeness and image of God and possesses the highest dignity by being a special creation of God. Maybe this week we can set some time aside for prayer and ask ourselves, How do I show my love for God? And how do I show God's love to my neighbour?

31st Sunday November 1st (All Saints Day)

Today is All Saints Day! If we go into any church we know from the surroundings that we are not alone. Never alone, because first and foremost, Christ is present in his Word, in a most august way in the sacrament of the Eucharist, and in his people. And in almost any Church, we look around at the stained glass, carvings or statues, and we get a further sense that we are not alone. Why? Because there is a wider Communion of Saints that unites believers across time and space, even across the boundary that divides this world from the next. Why are they saints? Because they took up the challenge of faith in their own time and space! Since the 4th century all the martyrs of the Church were honored collectively on their "dias notalis," the day of their death, and since the 9th century, the Feast of All Saints was firmly established as part of the Church year. So we honor collectively all the saints; those officially recognized and those known only to God. The true company of saints is far more numerous than the list of those formally canonized. We pray for faithfulness to the Gospel, so one day our descendents will be able to celebrate our feast on All Saints Day! Can we live here on earth as if it were heaven, where the order of the day is obedience to God's way? May the saints intercede for us and draw us ever closer to God and to each other!


