28th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Thanksgiving

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time – October 16th

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples a parable about the need to **pray always and not to lose heart!** He tells of a widow who consistently asks a harsh judge to grant her justice. She would not relent. She hounds him, and in the end her request is granted! The Gospel ends with a question, "...when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" We know very well what he will find happening around the world... painful and sad indeed. But, will he find us **persevering** in prayer and faith. We need to pray constantly, morning, noon and night. Many give up on prayer when the prayer seems to go unanswered? The most powerful of all prayers, I believe, is the **"Our Father!"** In that prayer we are asking God to **"let His will be done!"** Not mine! And that's a very trusting thing. It's called surrendering! That's putting God in control. Because God always knows what's best for us. O God, give us the courage to pray, the courage to let you be God, and the courage to accept your Holy Will!
