# Dear Friends:

Our Gospel today tells us about the generosity of God. Jesus tells a parable about a **generous landowner**. He hired workers at 5 different times during the day. At evening, no matter how long the labourers



worked, all received the same pay! Of course, there was grumbling and complaints! Not fair! They were angry and furious! One of them bravely spoke up to the landowner! But he said: I haven't done anything wrong to you. I paid you what you bargained for. I've met the terms of your contract,

so take what belongs to you and go. It's my money and I can do with it as I choose. Are you envious because I am generous?

Are you envious because I am generous? Great question! Jesus is explaining what the Kingdom of heaven is like. This is all about the generosity of God, the grace of God. These are God's ways. And God's ways are not our ways. God does the unexpected and surprises everyone!

We are all equal in God's eyes and equally needed in the vineyard at every hour of the day. In **baptism** we all came into the vineyard with Christ and we began to share in the healing, reconciling work of the kingdom. What matters is that early or late we get to know God and to work side by side with Christ doing **God's work in the world... in our towns... in our church... in our families**.

This is a *strong invitation* ... a call... to build up God's Kingdom. How generous am I with my time, talents and treasure? Do I do what I can to build up the community? Or am I just full of grumbles and complaints? Do I serve others, or just myself? Do I make sacrifices for others or just give out of my surplus? Is there somewhere I can serve in the parish or at our liturgies? Am I using the gifts I have for the benefit of others? Do I mirror the generous! When we show kindness and generosity to others, we not only make their lives better, but we also feel better about ourselves. In short, they give us the power to make the world a better place. Have a generous week!
