

#### Dear Friends,

It's good to be back from Newfoundland. I had an enjoyable time with my family and friends. I celebrated my niece's wedding, and baptized my great niece and nephew, and a cousin. My mother is doing fairly well, but is certainly not looking forward to winter. We keep her in prayer as she struggles with a limited mobility, and spinal problems.

It's hard to believe that September is here, and our schools re-opened this past Tuesday. We pray for our students, parents, teachers, principals and staff, as they begin this school year. We will celebrate an Opening School Mass this Tuesday at 9:30 AM for St. Patrick and St. Mary Schools. We also pray for our young adults who are returning to college and university, especially those who are moving away from home for the first time. Transitions are much easier when God is part of it!

In today's first reading from Isaiah, we hear, "Here is your God. He will come and save you... the eyes of the blind shall be opened and the ears



of the deaf unstopped." That was a great promise, and when we look at today's Gospel, we can see how this was fulfilled in Jesus when he heals a man who was deaf, and had a speech impediment. Jesus TOUCHED him while looking up to heaven, sighed and said, "Ephphatha", Be opened! And so it was! But it was more than just a touch! Jesus put his fingers in the man's ear,

and even spat and **touched** the man's tongue! Jesus wanted to physically identify with his infirmities, [and ours as well.]

Jesus still heals, and is more than aware of our hurts and ills. Maybe it's a physical illness, a life threatening illness, a psychological illness, addiction, low self esteem, or maybe we're fighting against our own tendencies to sin. Jesus is more than aware, and his love for us is intense. He hurts with us. No problem or burden is too much for Him!

How can we not think about what's happening in our Church? We pray this Sunday that Jesus will send the healing power of His Holy Spirit into Mother Church. We know, and God certainly knows, that there have been many atrocities and sin committed by those who were supposed to be leaders in the Church, supposed to be ministers of love, compassion and justice. We need to come together as a People of God, and pray together for healing for all victims of abuse. We pray that those atrocities will never happen again. This coming Friday at 7:00 PM, Bishop Bergie will preside at a Mass of Penance and Healing at the Cathedral. It's good that we as a Church can come together and acknowledge the sin, show repentance, and move toward healing and reconciliation. It's a good start.

May the gentle touch of Jesus, stir us all into healing, and stir our Church to greater Accountability and Holiness. Have a blessed week.
