Thank you for your support of the campaign! Throughout the One Heart One Soul campaign which began in June 2019, we had 107 Parishioners give either a one-time, monthly or annual contribution to the campaign. Some people are still fulfilling their pledges. Our Parish will receive 75% of the money raised by our Parishioners, and the remaining money stays with the Diocese of Hamilton. In turn, the Diocese will use 10% of money raised to support Parishes in desperate need of help in our Diocese. Another 15% of money raised will support shared Diocesan Ministries. So far, St. Aloysius Parishioners have paid \$120,241.00 towards their amount pledged, and we will receive 75% of that money to assist with a few major projects at St. Aloysius. We have fallen very short of our original campaign goal of \$365,238.66.

The One Heart One Soul fundraising money has been earmarked for a few major projects at St. Aloysius Parish including;

RESURFACING THE PARKING LOT Our parking lot was last resurfaced in the 1980s, and it is in serious need of repair. Some of the funds will help us to complete the project sooner rather than later.

REFURBISHING OUR BEAUTIFUL CHURCH

Our hope is to complete the covering on the large window at the loft end of the church to combat the sun. The blinding rays make things difficult for our priests and lectors! We have wanted to refurbish the pews for many years which have been suffering from noticeable scratches and other wear. Our heavy main doors into the church building are also in need of repair.

FUTURE FUND: Our original goal was to also build a 'Future Fund' from part of the One Heart One Soul fundraising money to help prepare for major or unexpected expenses. At this point, we will be unable to set up the future fund since not enough has been raised through the campaign.


