Weekly Gospel Reflection (Jn 10: 11-18)

Today we reflect on the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who carries the lost sheep on His shoulders. Our God is a God who takes us upon His shoulders and carries us! The ancient Greeks imagined *Atlas*, one of the Titans, who carried the world on his shoulders to prevent it from the fall into nonexistence. We, Christians, can say that our God is a God who carries a wounded world on His shoulders.

Christ, the Good Shepherd, searches for the lost sheep, each of us, and accompanies us even in the 'deserts' of our lives. And when He finds us, He takes us upon His shoulders and brings us home.

Sacrament Update First Communion and Confirmation

Due to the current Provincial restrictions, First Communion scheduled for May 2 has been postponed. First Communion and Confirmation scheduled for later in May will likely need to be postponed; further information will be forthcoming as we approach the end of the Stay-at-Home Order.

Sacrament of Baptism

Please complete the online registration form to begin the process of preparing your family for this Sacrament. Baptisms usually take place the last Sunday of the month. There is currently a limit of 10 people including the priest.

Wedding/Funerals

Weddings and funerals are currently limited to 10 people including the priest. For funerals it is recommended that only the Rite of Christian Burial at the cemetery take place in accord with the requirements of the Provincial Order and the Ontario Bereavement Authority.
