

St. Philip and St. James, Apostles Feast Day, Wednesday May 3rd, Mass at 12:15 pm

Philip and James were among the 12 apostles of Jesus. Philip was born in Bethsaida in Galilee. Finding his friend Nathaniel, Philip told him that Jesus was the one whom Moses and the other prophets had foretold (Jn 1:45). James is called "Lesser" because he was younger than the other Apostle by the same name, James the Great. James the Lesser after Jesus' Ascension into heaven, became the head of the Church in Jerusalem. He met his death as a martyr in that city about the year 62. Tradition identifies James as the author of the epistle associated with his name.

Why is May the Month of Mary?

The tradition of dedicating the month of May to Mary, came about in the 13th century. The pious practice of honouring Mary during the month of May has been promoted by Pope, Pius XII in his Encyclical *Mediator Dei* (MD, 182).

Devotion to Mary is an important part of the Catholic identity because Mary is an example of a committed "Yes" to the will of God. Since Mary was given to us as our Mother at the foot of the Cross, many people ask her for help and intercession in the most difficult situations of their lives as any child does with his mother.
