The Passion of St. John the Baptist, August 29

The Beheading of St. John the Baptist.

"... John the Baptist did not limit himself to teaching repentance or conversion. Instead, in recognizing Jesus as the "Lamb of God" who came to take away the sin of the world" (Jn 1:29), he had the profound humility to hold up Jesus as the One sent by God, drawing back so that He might take the lead, and be heard and followed. As his last act the Baptist witnessed with his blood to faithfulness to God's commandments, without giving in or withdrawing, carrying out his mission to the very end... the Venerable Bede says in one of his homilies: "St. John gave his life for Christ. He was not ordered to deny Jesus Christ, but was ordered to keep silent about the truth". And he did not keep silent about the truth and thus died for Christ who is the Truth." (Excerpt from Benedict XVI, General Audience, 29 August 2012).

World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation – Thursday, September 1st. Mass 12:15pm.

In 2015, Pope Francis declared September 1st as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Coinciding with a celebration instituted by the Orthodox Church, it is also a day of ecumenical prayer and unity.


