What is the story behind Our Lady of Guadalupe? On December 9, 1531... our Lady appeared to a native peasant named Juan Diego asking for a church to be built in her honor ... Our Lady asked Juan to collect some flowers from Tepeyac Hill ... and then the Blessed Mother arranged the roses in Juan Diego's tilma... Upon opening his tilma before the bishop ... the miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was revealed as the roses fell to the ground. ... Today there is a Shrine Church north of México City in Tulpetlac marking the place of this apparition and healing of Juan Bernardino. (Excerpt: ewtn.com)

According to the doctrine of the Catholic Church, the era of public revelation ended with the death of the last living Apostle. A Marian apparition, if deemed genuine by Church authority, is treated as private revelation ... The Holy See has officially confirmed the apparitions at Guadalupe, Saint-Etienne-le-Laus, Paris (Rue du Bac, Miraculous Medal), La Salette, Lourdes, Fatima, Portugal, Pontmain, Beauraing, and Banneux.
