Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 3:10-18; Zeph 3:14-18)

# Public Masses have resumed


We may welcome the number of people we can accommodate with two metres of social distance between individuals/households. All who participate in the liturgy are to wear masks.

### GAUDETE SUNDAY

The third Sunday of Advent is known as "Gaudete Sunday." Its name is taken from the entrance antiphon of the Mass. In Latin, the first word of the antiphon is Gaudete - "Rejoice." Advent is the season of preparing for the arrival of the Lord Jesus Christ (both His first coming and His second coming). Since by the third Sunday of Advent we are most of the way through the season, it is appropriate to rejoice. "The Lord is near!"
