The History of the First Nativity Scene

St. Francis of Assisi is given the credit for creating the first Nativity scene in 1223 in the Italian city of Greccio. To celebrate the birth of Jesus, Francis wanted to recreate the experience of the first Christmas. He did this not with statues inside a church, but with animals in a humble hilltop grove. ... According to St. Bonaventure, a miracle occurred on that night, a valiant and veracious soldier ... affirmed that he beheld an Infant marvellously beautiful, sleeping in the manger, Whom the blessed Father Francis embraced with both his arms as if he would awake Him from sleep. ... The idea caught on quickly and in 1291 the first Franciscan pope (Nicholas IV) commissioned statues to create the first permanent Nativity scene in the Roman Basilica of St. Mary Major.
