DID YOU KNOW? ENTERING AND LEAVING GESTURES

It is the Catholic custom, upon entering and leaving the Church, to make the sign of the cross with holy water. Traditionally, one uses the right hand, dips it into the holy water fonts, found at each entrance which symbolize the baptismal font, and then makes the sign of the cross by touching the forehead, chest, left then right shoulder. This action expresses our belonging to Christ, is a reminder of our baptismal share in the life of Christ, and a sign of our union with fellow believers as members of the Body of Christ. It is then most appropriate to genuflect before entering our pew or if physically unable to bow. These gestures also remind us that we are entering a solemn place where a spirit of silence permits people within the Church the quiet which prayer before Mass deserves. Thank you for keeping that spirit of sacred silence in our Church before and after Mass.

FROM LAST WEEK.....

Over the past few months consultation has taken place regarding the question of the time of the Solemn Mass of Christmas (traditionally held at Midnight). Over the last few years, I am told, that attendance has decreased at this Mass, and it has become difficult to obtain liturgical ministers. In addition, this year, it has also become apparent that we will not, due to various commitments, have a traditional choir present if the Mass time remains unchanged.

Therefore, following several discussions with parish groups, and in consultation with the Diocese of Hamilton, it has been decided that we will adopt a practice undertaken by other parishes, and **the Solemn Mass of Christmas will take place at 10:00pm this year** and not at Midnight. This decision, though not one all may embrace, will permit us to host a traditional choir, have more liturgical ministers present, and hopefully alleviate some attendance at other Masses to make it a more enjoyable experience for all. I thank all who have given input on this matter. Let us pray for God's graces as we continue to move forward as a Family of Faith.
