Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 1:12-15)



Jesus was tempted by Satan for forty days. "Forty" is a biblical number of testing and trial. Temptations began with words, "**If you are the Son of God** ..." (Mt 4:3). It is to say, 'If you are truly loved by God, let Him demonstrate that love.'

Feast of the Chair of St. Peter. Thursday, February 22, Mass at 12:15

The feast of the Chair of Saint Peter celebrates Peter and his successors as bishop of Rome. Pope Benedict XVI (2006): "Cathedra literally means the ... seat of the Bishop ... it is the symbol of the Bishop's authority and ... his magisterium, that is, the evangelical teaching which ... he is called to safeguard and to transmit to the Christian Community. Celebrating the "Chair" of Peter means ... recognizing it as a privileged sign of the love of God." (Living with Christ)

Why Fast During Lent?

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops decrees that the days of fast and abstinence in Canada are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fridays are days of abstinence, but Catholics can substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. Our Catechism states: "You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church" (CCC 2043). The purpose of this precept is twofold. First, it is intended to help us prepare ourselves spiritually for Easter. Secondly, it helps us grow in self-discipline and awaken our hunger for God and His words. "Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Mt. 4:4).
