FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 1:40-45)



Forty days Jesus was tempted by Satan. The devil began temptations saying, "If you are the Son of God ..." (Lk 4:3). In all three temptations, Satan wanted to proove that Jesus was not loved by His Father. As Fr. Rolheiser points out, in essence Satan is saying, 'If you are truly loved by God, why are you in this miserable situation in the desert?'

Similarly, the devil addresses each of us, 'If you believe you are God's loved one, why suffering in your life, why illness, emptiness ...?' Resisting temptations Jesus shows that being loved by God is not dependent upon being exempt from afflictions. Trusting that we are loved by God gives us inner strength. As Jesus was not disappointed, we won't be either.

Dear Parishioners, as our church is open for public Masses, I very much look forward to welcoming everyone back. May God grant us safe and blessed return to our worship together. Pax Christi.

Q. How can I make a gift or pledge to the campaign?

- Setting up a recurring credit card payment
- Paying by cash or cheque through the mail
- Making a stock or securities transfer

Q. Are cash pledges the only kind of gifts?

A. Because many of the needs of the campaign will require immediate funding, gifts of cash and appreciated securities are generally sought. But trust and estate gifts are welcomed. Donors considering a planned gift should contact the Diocesan Development Director, Francis Doyle, at 905-528-7988 to discuss the options available.

Q. Will we get reminders about our pledges during the three years of the campaign?

A. Yes, regular giving updates and reminders will be sent through the Diocese.


