

<u>NEW TO THE PARISH</u> • Please come and introduce yourself and complete a registration form available on our website at www.stmichaelw.ca or on the hospitality desks at each entrance to the church.

<u>PARISH RECORDS</u> • Our parish records are very important and we try to keep them as up to date as possible. Please advise the office if you change your address or telephone number.

MINISTRY TO PARISH SCHOOLS • The staff visit St. Nicholas and Sir Edgar Bauer on a regular basis. Eucharist and Reconciliation are celebrated with each school during the year and the staff is available for classroom visits and other special celebrations. We also celebrate the sacraments and make pastoral visits to St. David's high school as needed.

MINISTRY TO UNIVERSITY & COLLEGE STUDENTS • St. Michael's Parish welcomes students to participate in the liturgical and pastoral life of the parish. During the academic year we have a student mass on Sunday evenings at 7:00 p.m. that focuses on the pastoral needs of students. We also have the John Paul II Student Centre which is available for students. Please see www.jp2waterloo.ca for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION • For more information about preparation and dates please visit our website or contact the parish office.

MARRIAGE • Please meet with the priest or deacon before making any other arrangements. Twelve (12) months notice is normally required so that proper preparation can take place.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK AND SHUT-IN • Trained volunteers assist in the pastoral care of those who are sick or confined, whether at home, at retirement residences, long term care facilities or in hospitals. Anointing of the Sick is celebrated at Columbia Forest Long Term Care, The Village at University Gates, The Court at Laurelwood and Clair Hills Retirement Community twice a year. Parishioners can request the Anointing of the Sick at any time by appointment in their home or in the church.

<u>PASTORAL CARE TO THOSE WHO ARE IN HOSPITAL</u> • Privacy of information laws prohibit the parish from obtaining information about parishioners in hospital. A family member is asked to contact the parish office whenever a parishioner is in hospital and requests a pastoral visit.

PARISH OUTREACH • St. Michael's Parish assists those in need through the St. Vincent De Paul Society. For emergency food help call 519-747-1090.

MUSIC IN THE LITURGY • Music plays an integral role in the liturgical life of the parish. Parishioners are invited to sing with the traditional choir (9:00 a.m.) or the contemporary choir (11:00 a.m.) on Sunday morning.

REFUGEE UPDATE

- In December, St. Michael's, as the Constituent Group, submitted two more Refugee Sponsorship applications to the Office of Refugees at the Diocese. These were approved by the Diocese and submitted to the Government of Canada prior to the year-end. One of these is for a Palestinian family, stateless, all born in Syria and currently in Qatar. The second is for a Rohingya family that fled Myanmar because of persecution and have lived in a refugee camp in Bangladesh for 25 years. The Palestinian family will be funded by a friend here in Waterloo. St. Michael's is currently fundraising for the Rohingya family. Please keep these families in your prayers.
- The Syrian family that St. Michael's supported in 2016 has some great news to share. The husband/father left the family in Lebanon and went looking for work in September 2014. He was stranded in Germany when his family received refuge in Canada. But now all his security/medical checks have been completed and he is flying to Canada on January 15th to rejoin his three children and his wife. There is a "Welcome to Canada" card in the vestibule - if you wish to write him a message of welcome or just sign your name.
- There has been a request for a sewing machine (must be in excellent condition) from a Syrian newcomer. She has advanced enough in her language skills that she can participate in a sewing class but needs her own machine. Another family has requested a queen-size bed. The older couple was given a double-bed when they arrived because of space limitations but now have a bigger bedroom and would sleep better with a queen-size.
