FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 10:25-37)



Prior to Jesus, the term neighbor would not include stranger or enemy; the neighbor meant one's fellow countrymen, that is, another Israelite. The parable of the Good Samaritan reshapes the traditional definition of the neighbor; the neighbor is anyone who needs my help. The question to ask is not "Who is my neighbor?" but rather "Whose neighbor can I be in my circumstances?"

Martin Luther King commenting on today's parable points out that the first question that the priest and the Levite asked was, "If I stop to help this man, what will happen to me?" But when the Good Samaritan came by, he reversed the question: "If I do not stop to help this man, what will happen to him?


