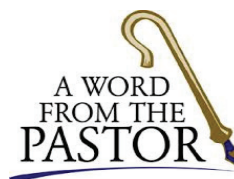
PARISH LIBRARY

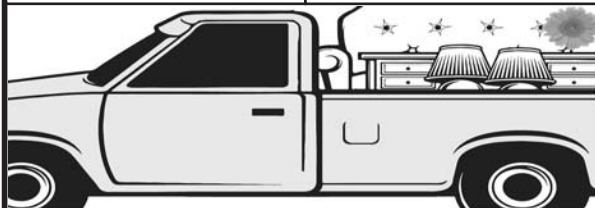
