Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 4: 26-34)



Jesus presents two parables, and both are metaphors of hope. He says that the Kingdom of God is like a seed planted in the ground. It grows hidden from our eyes and though smallest at the beginning it becomes largest of all, but only later in time. The Kingdom of God is not to be equated with a place; it signifies a time when God enters our life and transforms evil into goodness.

The two parables are a metaphorical way of saying that there is redemption from all evil that we face in our life. God always transforms darkness to light, but not necessarily as fast as we would wish. Out of His love for us, God will transform the deserts in our life into green and gigantic gardens, if we only trust in Him and hope in His steadfast love.

## **World Refugee Day**

Every year, the UNHCR celebrates World Refugee Day on June 20<sup>th</sup>. This day celebrates the strength and courage of people forced to flee their homes to escape conflict or persecution and reminds all of us that we need to work together to create a more just, inclusive and equal world. This year, the UNHCR estimates that 1% of the world's population (80 million) has been forcibly displaced. Of this number, 26.3 million are refugees. Please pray for all displaced people and, in particular, for the 3 refugees families (Rohingya, Syrian and Iraqi) currently being sponsored by St. Michael's parish. 
