Weekly Gospel Reflection (Lk 9:11-17)

Today we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ**, in Latin *Corpus Christi*. The Gospel portrays the Eucharist through the image of multiplication of the loaves. By the broken bread of his very body, Jesus feeds our hungry hearts. This miracle illustrates a paradox, namely, multiplication comes through giving away. Rainer Maria Rilke, an Austrian poet, makes an insightful comment on today's passage, "*This is the miracle that happens every time to those who really love; the more they give, the more they possess*."

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi

What does the Solemnity of Corpus Christi celebrate? Also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, this feast honors Jesus Christ, Really, Truly and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance"), when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body", "This is the chalice of My Blood". "Do this in remembrance of Me". It is celebrated on the Thursday following the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. (*From: EWTN.com/Catholicism*)
