

"Drawing primarily from the experiences of Christian saints throughout the ages, biblical stories, as well as Father David's personal experiences, this book engages what it means for us to live life deeply with God in today's world!" This weekend, I am in Toronto participating in activities at the Newman Centre in Toronto – the Campus Ministry at the University of Toronto. I am also taking this time to participate in planning discussions concerning our parish youth participation in the Steubenville Toronto Conference which takes place in July. Thank you for remembering me in your prayers. I will be back on Monday.

In this month of June, some 47 priests of our Diocese will be "on the move". A total of six will be retiring, and another three will be on a Leave of Absence, the remaining 38 will be transitioning to new parish assignments. We pray for them, and for the parishes affected. Change and transition is something which occurs in parish life. We have, as a parish, experienced it on the clergy level, and recently we have experienced it with our lay staff. For St Michael Parish, the Diocese of Hamilton will be transitioning us to a new revised full time Administrative Assistant position which will encompass both administrative and bookkeeping duties. This will allow our parish office to be open 5 days per week. This new role will also offer administrative support to the St John Paul Student Centre. The Diocese of Hamilton will be leading the selection process for this new role and details on the position can be found on - www.hamiltondiocese.com

Next weekend will be a very exciting weekend for us with our Service Saturday (over 50 parishioners & students involved), and Sunday at 11:00am Mass; adult Baptisms and three Confirmations. Great signs of life for our Family of Faith!
