Weekly Gospel Reflection (Jn 20:19-23)

Today we celebrate *Pentecost*, *50 days* after the Resurrection of Jesus, when the Holy Spirit fills the hearts of the disciples. We may wonder who exactly the Holy Spirit is. The most essential truth we can say is that the Holy Spirit is the Love of God. The Holy Spirit is Love that exists between the Father and the Son. So, when the Holy Spirit fills our hearts, it is the Love of God that fills us.

It means, whenever we find charity in ourselves, whenever we are faithful in the midst of hardships, whenever we forgive or ask for forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we can be sure, the Holy Spirit is at work within us.

Solemnity of Pentecost:

"...today's Gospel presents these beautiful words to us: 'the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord' (Jn 20:20). These words are profoundly human. The Friend lost is present once again and those who were formerly distraught rejoice. But it says far more. For the lost Friend did not come from just anywhere but from the night of death; and He passed through it! He is not just anyone; indeed, He is the Friend and at the same time the One who is the Truth that gives life to men and women; and what He gives is not just any kind of joy but joy itself, a gift of the Holy Spirit. Yes, it is beautiful to live because I am loved and it is the Truth who loves me. The disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Today, at Pentecost, these words are also addressed to us, because in faith we can see Him. In faith He comes among us and to us too He shows His hands and His side and we are glad. Therefore, let us pray: Lord, show yourself! Make us the gift of your presence and we shall have the most beautiful gift: your joy. Amen!"
