FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Weekly Gospel Reflection (Jn 16:12-15)



Today we celebrate the **Trinity Sunday**. To believe in God as the Trinity is to believe that there is the Father who lives **for** the Son, that there is the Son who lives **for** the Father, and that there is the Holy Spirit who is a mutual answer to that loving relationship. Since we are created in the “image and likeness” of God, it means we are created to live **for** someone else not for ourselves. “**To live for someone else**” is the key to ‘understand’ the Trinity. The mystery of the Trinity reveals that none of us is an isolated island. Each one of us can be himself/herself, find happiness and meaning only by living “for” others.

Holy Trinity Sunday

What is Holy Trinity Sunday? “The Catholic Church celebrates this unfathomable mystery each year on the Sunday following Pentecost... The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (paragraphs 234 and 253) teaches, “The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the ‘hierarchy of the truths of faith’ ... The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the ‘consubstantial Trinity’. The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire...” (Excerpt from: *EWTN.com/Catholicism*)

The Sacred Heart of Jesus

June has become known as the Month of the Sacred Heart, due to the fact that the feast of the Sacred Heart is celebrated each year during it. It all started in 1675 when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received private revelations from Jesus Christ requesting to celebrate this *special Feast* the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi, which is celebrated after Trinity Sunday, that falls during the month of June. The precise date fluctuates each year, as it is determined by the celebration of Easter. It wasn't until 1856 when the universal Church officially started celebrating this feast and ever since then the month of June has been focused on the devotion to the Heart of Jesus and His divine love for humanity.
