FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday's Gospel Reflection (Lk 9:28-36)



It is striking that in the midst of His glorious Transfiguration Jesus speaks about His 'exodus' in Jerusalem, that is, about His suffering and death (Lk 9:31). In this way Christ wants us to know that suffering and death is not the last word, not for Christ, and not for us.

Indeed, the Greek word for 'transfiguration' *metamorphosis* is used in the New Testament in reference to Christ and those who believe in Him (2Cor 3:18ff). It is to say, that God's glory is manifested in our lives not only when we are most successful and healthy but also when we are bound down by illness or suffering.


Masks are required by all who attend Mass, two-years old and older.
