FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sunday Gospel Reflection (Jn 12: 20-33)



Jesus says, "Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit." The Lord is speaking about Himself, about His death as the means of gaining life to all. He also speaks here about us.

This metaphor reveals deep truth about Christ and about our human life. It reminds us of a truth that any loving parent and any selfless person testifies to, namely, it is in dying to ourselves that we give life to others. In Jesus' words, to remain wrapped up in self, is to lose one's life; to be generous in giving of self is to find life and be a source of life to others (see, Jn 12:25).
