Laetare Sunday

Today, the Fourth Sunday of Lent, is called *Laetare Sunday*. The name comes from the first words of the Entrance Antiphon for Mass, "*Laetare Jerusalem*" — "*Rejoice, O Jerusalem*." We rejoice as this Sunday marks the half-way point of our Lenten journey to the Resurrection of the Lord. Symbolizing joy, rose-colored Mass vestments may be worn instead of purple. Solo instrumental music is permitted, and the altar may be decorated with flowers.

Solemnity of St. Joseph, March 20

We don't have any words from St. Joseph, Jesus' father on earth, but we have so many reflections from the saints who have loved him dearly.

Padre Pio: "Ite ad Joseph. Go to Joseph with extreme confidence, because I do not remember having asked anything from St. Joseph, without having obtained it readily." (Excerpt from: aleteia.org)

Pope Benedict XVI especially encouraged married couples and parents to turn to St. Joseph, saying: "God alone could grant Joseph the strength to trust the Angel. Mary accepted God's will saying, "'Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.'"
