The Church is Open for Prayer


The Church is open for quiet prayer Monday to Friday, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

All Day Confessions Wednesday, April 5

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available from **8 am to 9 pm**. Mass will be at 12:15. Confessions will pause during Mass then will continue until 9:00 pm.

Reconciliation (also known as **Confession**) is a sacrament instituted by Jesus Christ in His love and mercy to offer us forgiveness for our sins. "Every time we go to confession, God embraces us" - Pope Francis. Confession can be challenging but it is not difficult. To engage in the Sacrament in a meaningful way does require preparation. There are various types of examinations of conscience. They should be rooted in Scripture; particularly, the Ten Commandments or Beatitudes.
