Optional Memorial of Saints Perpetua and Felicity, Thursday, March 7
- Mass at 12:15

Perpetua, a noblewoman, and Felicity, a slave, two courageous women were killed for their faith on March 7, 203, in Carthage. During the persecution of Christians by Emperor Severus, several catechumens were arrested, among them Perpetua with her infant son and the pregnant Felicity. They were baptized while under arrest. After being flogged, the Christians were led to the amphitheatre, exposed to the wild beasts and beheaded. (*Living with Christ*)

## Why no meat on Fridays?

On Fridays, we refrain from eating meat because Jesus died for us on Good Friday. Traditionally meat was more expensive and eaten only during times of feasting and rejoicing. Fish is permitted on Fridays because it doesn't belong to the "flesh meats." Flesh meat includes any meat from poultry or mammals, such beef, chicken, and pork. Products that come from these animals can be consumed on Fridays, such as milk and eggs. (*Archdiocese of Toronto*)


# Lent – a good time for meditation
