

WEEKDAY LITURGY SCHEDULE

<u>NEW TO THE PARISH</u> • Please come and introduce yourself and complete a registration form available on our website at www.stmichaelw.ca or on the hospitality desks at each entrance to the church.

<u>PARISH RECORDS</u> • Our parish records are very important and we try to keep them as up to date as possible. Please advise the office if you change your address or telephone number.

MINISTRY TO PARISH SCHOOLS • The staff visit St. Nicholas and Sir Edgar Bauer on a regular basis. Eucharist and Reconciliation are celebrated with each school during the year and the staff is available for classroom visits and other special celebrations. We also celebrate the sacraments and make pastoral visits to St. David's high school as needed.

MINISTRY TO UNIVERSITY & COLLEGE STUDENTS • St. Michael's Parish welcomes students to participate in the liturgical and pastoral life of the parish. During the academic year we have a student mass on Sunday evenings at 7:00 p.m. that focuses on the pastoral needs of students. We also have the John Paul II Student Centre which is available for students. Please see www.jp2waterloo.ca for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION • For more information about preparation and dates please visit our website or contact the parish office.

MARRIAGE • Please meet with the priest or deacon before making any other arrangements. Twelve (12) months notice is normally required so that proper preparation can take place.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK AND SHUT-IN • Trained volunteers assist in the pastoral care of those who are sick or confined, whether at home, at retirement residences, long term care facilities or in hospitals. Anointing of the Sick is celebrated at Columbia Forest Long Term Care, The Village at University Gates, The Court at Laurelwood and Clair Hills Retirement Community twice a year. Parishioners can request the Anointing of the Sick at any time by appointment in their home or in the church.

<u>PASTORAL CARE TO THOSE WHO ARE IN HOSPITAL</u> • Privacy of information laws prohibit the parish from obtaining information about parishioners in hospital. A family member is asked to contact the parish office whenever a parishioner is in hospital and requests a pastoral visit.

PARISH OUTREACH • St. Michael's Parish assists those in need through the St. Vincent De Paul Society. For emergency food help call 519-747-1090.

MUSIC IN THE LITURGY • Music plays an integral role in the liturgical life of the parish. Parishioners are invited to sing with the traditional choir (9:00 a.m.) or the contemporary choir (11:00 a.m.) on Sunday morning.

The Africa Committee would like to THANK supported the Child everyone who Sponsorship campaign last fall. Two cheques were sent to the NDCO from St. Michael's the majority of the funds in December 2017

and the balance a few weeks ago in 2018. In total, parishioners and friends of St. Michael's and St. Jerome's donated \$66,647.00 for the direct support of 120 children - elementary, secondary and post secondary. In late November, Sister Rose sent a list of the children and their school fees anticipated for 2018. This eliminated a lot of guesswork and we feel that the sponsored children are well looked after for the coming year. In addition, Sir Edgar Bauer School has been sponsoring 6 NDCO students for the last few years. As well, St. Michael's contributed \$8,000.00 towards the general needs of the NDCO. So "thank you - asante" to everyone.

One of the major challenges of this project is communication. Internet service at the NDCO home and office is very poor which is frustrating for us here as we try to get updates and information on the project and the children. It is also frustrating and time-consuming for the NDCO as they struggle to supply us with the information we ask for. So we ask for your patience and understanding. Sister Rose is in Nairobi this weekend and has promised to take advantage of better internet connections to answer all our questions.

Marriage Tip

We all know that positive reinforcement works best with children, but did you know it has a very positive influence on your married relationship as well? Do you compliment your spouse every day?
