NEW TO THE PARISH • Please come and introduce yourself and complete a registration form available on our website at www.stmichaelw.ca/forms or on the hospitality desks at each entrance to the church.

PARISH RECORDS • Our parish records are very important and we try to keep them as up to date as possible. Please advise the office if you change your address or telephone number.

MINISTRY TO PARISH SCHOOLS • Charlie Van Alphen and the pastoral staff visit St. Nicholas and Sir Edgar Bauer on a regular basis. Eucharist and Reconciliation are celebrated with each school during the year and the staff is available for classroom visits and other special celebrations. Fr. Con is available for the staff and students at St. David's school as needed.

MINISTRY TO UNIVERSITY STUDENTS AND STAFF • St. Michael's Parish welcomes students to participate in the liturgical and pastoral life of the parish. Each Sunday evening during the university academic year, we provide a parish Mass at 7:00 p.m. that focuses on the pastoral needs of students and staff of the universities and colleges in our community.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION • For more information about preparation and dates please visit our website or contact the parish office.

MARRIAGE • Couples intending to be married are asked to fill out an application form from the office or online at stmichaelw.ca/sacraments and meet with Fr. Con before making any other arrangements. Twelve (12) months notice is normally required so that proper preparation can take place.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK AND SHUT-IN • The Parish Nurse and trained volunteers assist in the pastoral care of those who are sick or confined, whether at home, at retirement residences, in nursing homes, in hospitals or in prison. Anointing of the Sick is celebrated in the parish church, Columbia Forest Long Term Care Centre and The Court At Laurelwood twice a year. Parishioners can request the Anointing of the Sick at any time by appointment in their home or in the church.

PASTORAL CARE TO THOSE WHO ARE IN HOSPITAL • Privacy of information laws prohibit the parish from obtaining information about parishioners in hospital. A family member is asked to contact the parish office whenever a parishioner is in hospital and requests a pastoral visit.

PARISH OUTREACH • St. Michael's Parish assists those in need through the St. Vincent De Paul Society. For emergency food help call 519-747-1090.

MUSIC IN THE LITURGY • Music plays an integral role in the liturgical life of the parish. Parishioners are invited to sing with the traditional choir (9:00 a.m.) or the contemporary choir (11:00 a.m.) on Sunday morning.

St. Michael's Church is the host of the World Day of Prayer for the City of Waterloo this year. This ecumenical prayer service will be held on Friday, March 7th at 1 PM. The history of World Day of Prayer goes back two centuries. This year, the prayer service, titled "Streams in the Desert", is written by the women of Egypt. Members of ten other Waterloo churches will join us in presenting this meaningful service. You will learn about the culture and heritage of Egypt. Our speaker Nevine Ebeid will speak of her personal experience on growing up in Egypt. This will be an interesting service for all age group. Come and join Christians and friends in over 170 countries around the world and over 2000 communities in Canada to pray and act in solidarity with the people of Egypt!



Denise Dolff will be returning to Rwanda on April 2nd for the 20th anniversary of the genocide. She is hoping to raise money to pay school fees for young men in the minor seminary who cannot afford even a toothbrush and toothpaste, and are in danger of having to withdraw because their families cannot afford the cost of \$500.00 US per year, or do so by selling their only farmland, resulting in even greater poverty. Denise is asking for donations of \$5.00 or more with a goal to subsidizing three seminarians with the assistance of St. Michael's Parish. As this is a personal undertaking, not a parish outreach, no income tax receipts can be issued, but envelopes marked "African Seminarian" can be placed in the collection or left at the church office for her to personally deliver.
