Weekly Gospel Reflection (Jn 20:19-23)



As we celebrate the *Feast of Pentecost, 50 days after the Resurrection*, when the Holy Spirit fills the hearts of the disciples, we wonder who exactly is the Holy Spirit. The most essential thing we can say is that the Holy Spirit is completely and truly God. The Holy Spirit is the Love that exists in relationship between the Father and the Son.
