Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mt 28:16-20)



To believe in God as the Trinity is to believe that there is the Father who lives **for** the Son, that there is the Son who lives **for** the Father, and that there is the Holy Spirit who is a mutual answer to that loving relationship.

Since we are created in the "image and likeness" of God, it means that we are created to live **for** others not for ourselves. To live "**for someone else**" is the key to understand the Trinity. It has been requested that we share the following announcement. On July 13, 2020, following a credible accusation of professional misconduct, Father Frank Freitas was suspended from exercising priestly ministry pending the results of an investigation into the allegation. Subsequently, following instructions from the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, a preliminary investigation was begun. In the course of the investigation, Father Frank Freitas freely requested a dispensation from the clerical state. On March 4, 2021, His Holiness Pope Francis granted Father Frank Freitas a dispensation from all priestly obligations, including celibacy. This means that, in accord with canon law, Frank Freitas is now unable to function in any capacity as a priest anywhere, with the exception of offering absolution to those in danger of death.
